- 1 Language and Human Training EU.

Program Exchange Semesters 5 (S5), students must validate 8 courses (UE) from those selected:

- 6 EUs (30 ECTS credits)
- 5 optional Technical EUs (IT and/or mathematics).

MATHEMATICAL SKILLS

You will need an aptitude for mathematics for the Computational Applied Mathematics MSc programmes and should have done some mathematics as part of your university degree as: Algebra, Linear Algebra, Analysis, Differential equations, Probability.

COMPUTING SKILLS

It is important for an Applied Mathematics practitioner to be able to use computers fluently to model and analyse new problems. This will involve programming in a high-level language. Applicants should have the following as part of an earlier degree: an undergraduate programming course (in any language e.g. R, MATLAB, C, C++, Fortran, Python); an understanding of flow control; the ability to use methods / functions.

ENGLISH SKILLS

- As the ENSIIE language of instruction is mainly French, French spoken students are welcome.
- If your first language is not English or your first degree is not from a British or US University, you will need to provide evidence of your ability at spoken and written English.

EXCHANGE STUDENTS APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- (1) Student who wish to join our exchange program should be nominated from home university. Nomination time is by July 15 for S3 and S5 and November 1 for S4.
- (2) Once nominated, the accepted students will receive the Letter of Acceptance.
- (3) The application will be done directly at school. End of August, students will receive a link for application . All application documents are to be uploaded to the platform.

FRENCH AS FOREIGN LANGUAGE

Summer session: 4 weeks of complete immersion into the French culture by teaching language and grammar concepts (ask for the fees).

Applied courses all year long (once a week):

ENSIIE offers its students a French course as a Foreign Language (FLE).

HOUSING

ENSIIE provides housing in *La Maisel* campus dormitory, 5 min walk from school.

MONTHLY RENT 550 €

Prices are indicative, they provide a satisfactory estimate of the leasing cost.
